SPECIAL PROVISION

(For Sign Material Requirements)

CONTROL OF MATERIALS

The materials used shall meet the current Michigan Department of Transportation Standard Specifications 919 Traffic Sign Materials and other applicable sections. Requirements for testing are waived and materials will be accepted for quality on the basis of a written certification from the supplier or contractor that the materials used meet MDOT specification requirements. The right is reserved to make check tests of materials as may be deemed necessary, and a confirmed pattern of noncompliance with specifications will be grounds for cancellation of certification privileges and rejection of the materials. Test results shall be reported to the Road Commission.

Material products used in conjunction with one another must be compatible and applied in accordance with the manufacturer's specification. For example, ink must be compatible to the sheeting. Suppliers of materials that are used with one another must state the product being used and must provide a statement or certification from the manufacturer relative to the product compatibility. All suppliers of sign materials must place their company identification on the product and advise the Road Commission in their bid proposal as to what and where the identification will be.

MUTUAL EXTENSION CLAUSE

This bid, by mutual agreement of both parties, may be extended for additional one-year periods, each year hereafter but not to exceed a maximum of two additional years. Requests for contract extensions must be in writing and received by the Road Commission no later than December 31st of each year.

RIGHT TO REJECT

The Road Commission may award bids in whole or parts thereof, reserve the right to reject any and all proposals, waive Irregularities in any bid and make award in any manner Deemed in the best interest of the Road Commission.
