

Wadhams Road & Bridge Replacement

Project **Start**
April 12, 2010

Project **Complete**
October 1, 2011

The St. Clair County Road Commission and Posen Construction Inc. have put together an anticipated schedule for the upcoming Wadhams Road & Bridge Reconstruction Project to help local motorists plan their daily commute for the remainder of 2010 through the end of the project on October 1, 2011. The scheduled dates are considered to be approximate and should be verified by visiting www.sccrc-roads.org for updated road restriction and closure information.

The Project

Scheduled to start on April 12, 2010 will replace the Wadhams Road Bridge over the Black River. Expect minor traffic disruptions from temporary paving and traffic shifts during the beginning period of the project.

Two lanes of traffic will be open on the partially completed new bridge by November 2010.

The second half of the new bridge will be completed during the 2011 construction season.

Traffic Closures

Daily lane closures using flag control will be used from 4/12/2010 to 4/24/2010.

Wadhams Road will be reduced down to one lane in each direction starting April 24, 2010 and continuing throughout construction. Traffic will be further reduced to one lane with flag-control during intermittent periods.

Atkins Road will be closed during construction only from Wadhams to about 400' to the east, follow posted detour. Atkins Road will reopen when the construction project is completed.

Intersections at Lapeer/Wadhams and N. River/Wadhams will have traffic shifts and turn restrictions, but will remain functional throughout construction.

Project Limits

The project begins at the north side of the Wadhams Road intersection with Lapeer Road and extends over the river to 300' north of the intersection with North River Road. Atkins Road from Wadhams to about 400' east of Wadhams.

Construction barrels and signs to control traffic will be in place beyond these limits and also along Lapeer Road.
